

Motor Milestones in Williams Syndrome



Are you a parent or a carer of a child with Williams Syndrome?

We are conducting an online-only study with parents and carers to understand how movement develops in children with Williams Syndrome. This will help us provide much-needed guidance on motor development in Williams Syndrome.



Participants will be asked to:

- Participate in an online longitudinal study (up to 24 months)
- Fill in a questionnaire every 6 months.
- Enter quarterly updates about the motor milestones of their child.
- Send a video of their child when they achieve independent walking (Optional).

We are looking for parents of children aged 0 to 60 months (5 years and younger).

Participants will receive:
